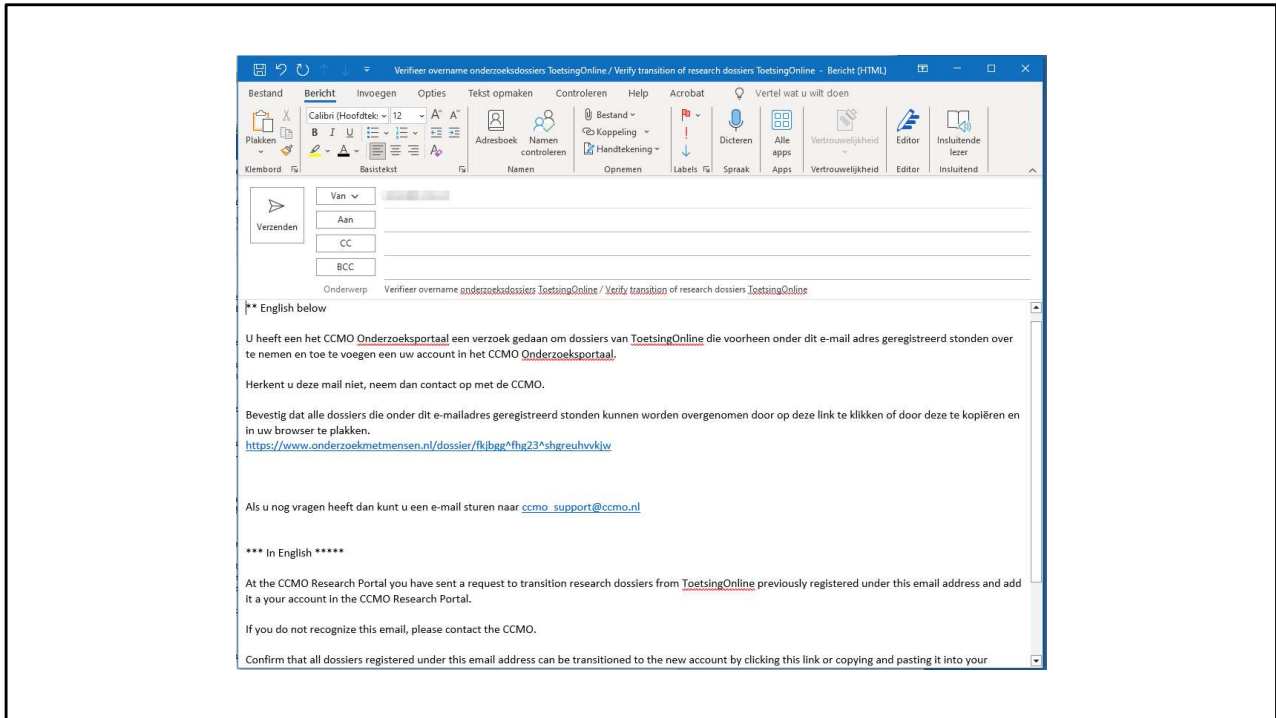

If the email address you enter matches the email address of your current Research Portal account, the dossiers will be automatically linked. If the email address differs, a verification process will be carried out to ensure that only authorized individuals gain access to the dossiers.

In this example the email address associated with the NTR account matches the one in the Research Portal, so the NTR studies are automatically linked. The email address associated with the ToetsingOnline account differs, so a verification code is sent to that email address to link the dossiers.



For each email address requiring validation, a verification email with a link will be sent to the provided email address. You must still have access to these email accounts.

If you no longer have access, you can contact the CCMO to transfer the dossiers.
